PASKE'S BIGBUILD BEGINS

WORK is set to begin within a fortnight on a new \$680,000 function centre at the Yorke Peninsula Field Days site near Paskeville, backed by a \$400,000 South Australian Government grant.

Complementing the site's recently completed office complex fronting Copper Coast Highway, the new centre will feature a similar design using corrugated metal silos.

The venue will also host agricultural and community activities year-round, generating economic and social benefits for the wider region.

Construction is expected to be completed in time for this year's biennial event, which will be held from Tuesday, September 29 to Thursday, October 1, although the centre will not be fitted out in time for use during the event.
